PETERBOROUGH, March 4, 2013 - The Community Foundation of Greater Peterborough (CFGFP) is pleased to announce that it is now accepting applications for its Organizational Leadership and Innovation Grants Program.

CFGFP grant programs are intended to support and encourage the effectiveness of local charitable organizations in meeting their missions and improving the quality of life in the City and County of Peterborough.

Organizational Leadership and Innovation Grants are investments that strengthen organizational infrastructure and leadership. Eligible applicants are registered Canadian charities operating with offices and programs within the City and/or County of Peterborough. Funding of up to \$3000 is available for projects that meet the granting priorities. This program has been made possible through the generous support of the CFGFP Directors' Fund. The deadline for applications is Friday, April 26th at 5:00 pm.

A Grants Assessment Committee made up of board and community members will review the applications submitted by charities and select the grant recipients. Recipients will be acknowledged at the CFGFP Community Celebration in June.
