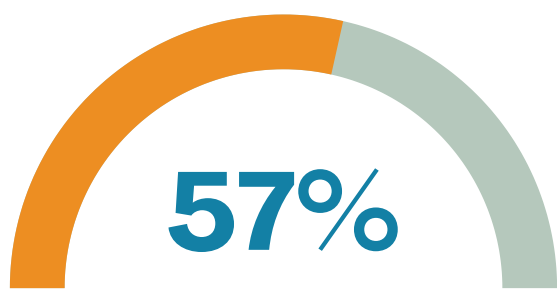


Local charities are innovative and resilient. But faced with increased demand and decreasing revenues, many organizations are uncertain about the future.
